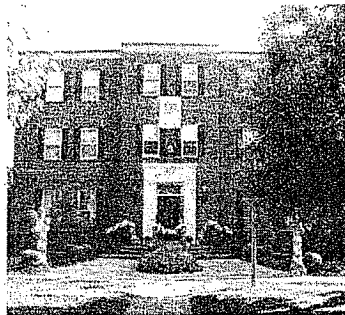

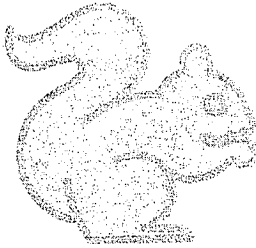
P R E S I D E N T ' S L E T T E R

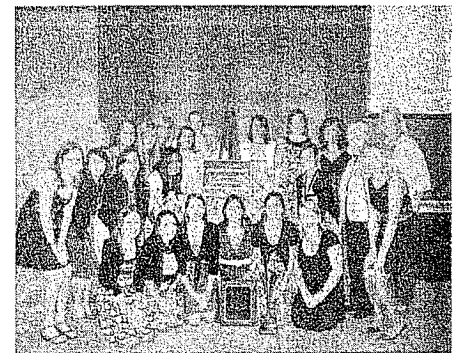
Collegiate members during the House Tour portion of the Centennial weekend performing their Recruitment skits.

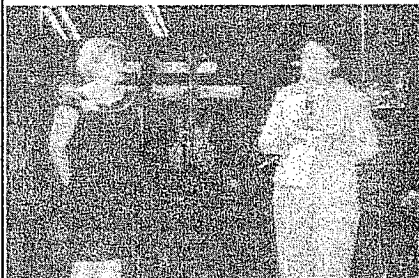

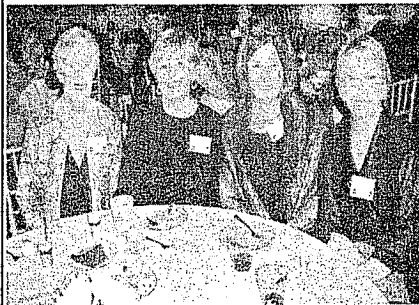

Alpha Gamma Delta Foundation Announces Scholarship Award Information and Updates

Indianapolis, IN. August 1, 2008 — The Alpha Gamma Delta Foundation announces scholarship award updates.

The Alpha Gamma Delta Foundation is scheduled to award \$106,850 in scholarships to alumnae and collegiate members of Alpha Gamma Delta for the 2008-2009 academic year.

Academic scholarships are awarded annually to alumnae pursuing a graduate degree as well as collegiate members pursuing an undergraduate degree. Applicants must be a member of Alpha Gamma Delta in good standing and enrolled in full time course work as documented with an institutional transcript. Applications are available from the Foundation office or under the Foundation tab at www.alphagammadelta.org.

All scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievements and financial need as well as chapter, campus and community participation. The Foundation is looking forward to recognizing the 101 women selected to receive scholarships this academic year.

The Foundation awards two types of academic scholarships; general and endowed.

General scholarships may be awarded to any member of Alpha Gamma Delta regardless of their chapter or field of study. General scholarships are made available through the generous donations of our chapters, clubs, alumnae and friends to the Foundation's annual fund.

Endowed scholarships are made available through the generosity of a particular donor or group of donors. Criteria for awarding endowed scholarships is determined by the donor(s) and is generally restricted to members of a specific chapter or members in a particular field of study.

We are also happy to announce that the Foundation was able to assist 31 alumnae sisters with Continuing Education opportunities this past year. Continuing Education Grants are awarded to alumnae sisters who have been out of school for at least two years and are attending seminars or classes on a part-time basis to advance their careers.

Are you going to school? Check out www.alphagammadeltafoundation.org for more information on scholarships (for full time students) and Continuing Education Grants (for part time students). Scholarship applications are due no later than March 1st. Continuing Education Grants applications are evaluated as they are submitted throughout the year.

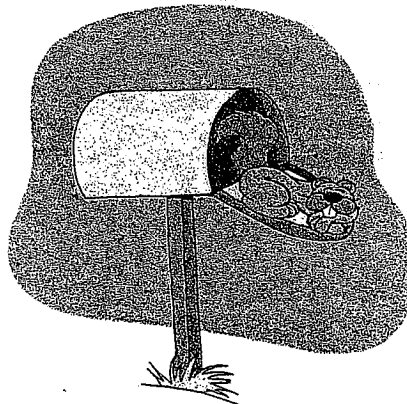
